Utah Forest Practices Act

65A-8a-103. Registration of Operators

- (1) An operator intending to conduct forest practices in Utah, except a landowner conducting forest practices on his or her own land for noncommercial purposes, shall register with the division.
- (2) The operator shall submit to the division:
 - (a) the name of the company and state of incorporation; and
 - (b) the name, telephone number, and address of a company officer and an on-the-ground supervisor.
- (3) In consultation with industry representation, the division may establish by administrative rule minimum requirements for registration such as financial responsibility or demonstrated performance capabilities.
- (4) The division shall make available to landowners a list of registered operators.
